

A potential change to the Highway code that will effect the village in 2022.

The decision is expected to be made to ban all parking on pavements in England and Wales.

It will be illegal to park on the pavement as it impedes the pavement for walkers, wheelchair users, parents and pushchairs and anyone reliant on a seeing dog. The local Council will have the power to issue an on the spot fine of £70.

Be aware this matter could be made law early this year.
