Ulgham Parish Council, who placed the Asset of Community Value (ACV) on the Forge Inn, received formal notification on 4th Sept 23 from Northumberland County Council (NCC) that the owner of the Forge Inn has now provided "NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DISPOSE OF A COMMUNITY ASSET". Following the presentation of the results of The Forge Inn Survey by Dave Wilson on 15th August, residents put themselves forward to set up a steering group. Now called Ulgham CBS (Community Benefit Society) a steering group has been formed and consist of Dave Wilson, Deb Wilson, Jen Ames, Lisa Critchon, Mark Turnbull, Neil Jamieson, Paul Barton.

The steering group are planning an **open meeting on Tuesday 24th October**. The intention is to provide a process update, but more important, encourage our residents to come along and engage with the group. It is an opportunity to collaborate and contribute, identify how you can share your skills to help us secure the future of our pub and establish a successful business which will include a pub, cafe and shop.
